- Know how to hold your own in a conversation, whilst not coming across as overpowering

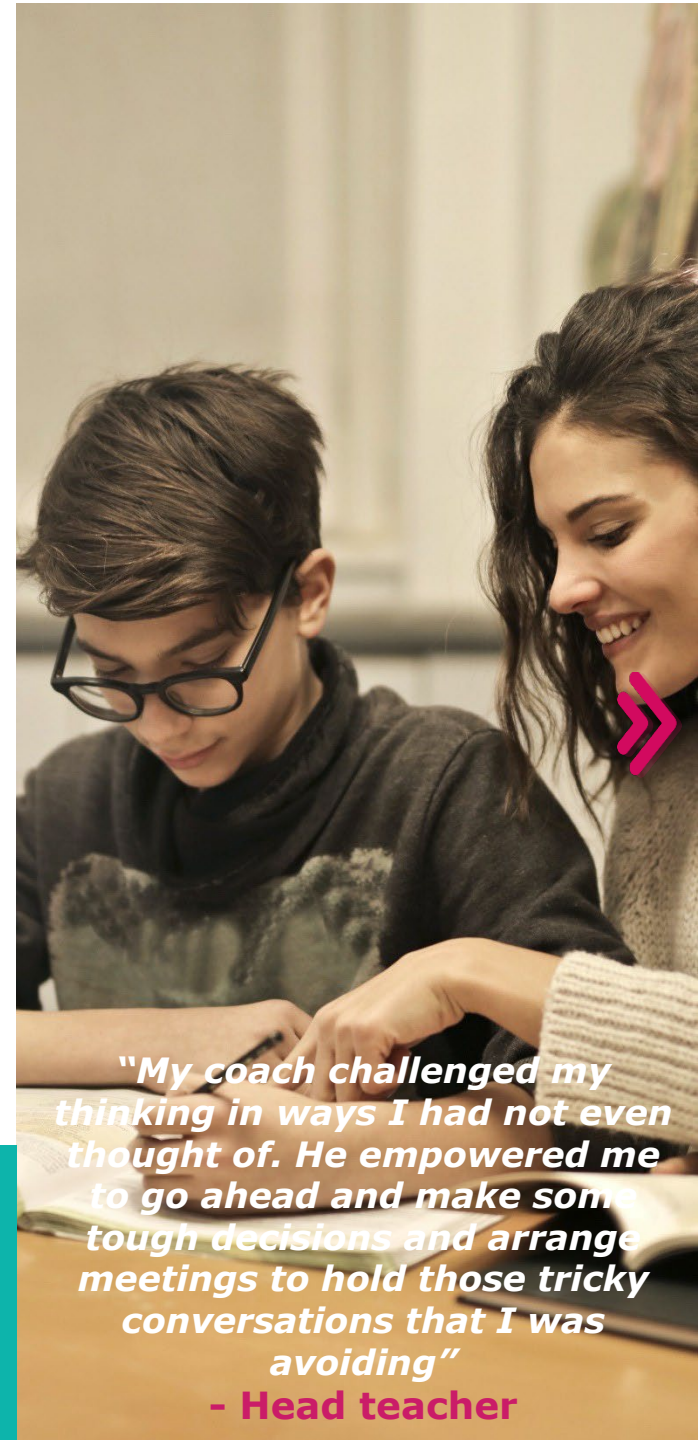
